The Importance of Secure Storage

Secure storage prevents shootings by disrupting unauthorized access to firearms.





Movement Towards a Culture of Safety

In Arizona, for example, pool owners must adhere to safety regulations regarding barriers and gates to prevent access. There are no safety regulations for gun owners in Arizona.

Which states/territories have child-access and/or secure storage



Full Locking Laws

The primary objective is to **prevent unauthorized access**, and not merely punish it.

Rates of unintentional shootings by children were **78 percent lower** in states requiring secure storage when the gun is not in the owner's possession.





Child-Access Prevention (CAP) Laws

CAP laws penalize gun owners either if a **child or a prohibited person** is likely to access it, or only after a child gains access to a firearm

Rates of unintentional shootings by children were **39 percent lower** in states with laws that apply when a child is likely to access a gun and **34 percent lower** in states with laws that apply when a child actually accesses an unsecured gun





Secure Storage in Vehicle Laws

Laws that require guns to be securely stored and not visible when left unattended in cars.

Cars parked at residences are the #1 source of stolen guns. A gun is stolen from a car every 9 minutes.

Public Awareness + Incentivization

Storage public education campaigns have been run in many states, including North Carolina, Oklahoma, Texas.

Public awareness on **"giving the keys"** as suicide prevention

Louisiana and Tennessee have passed legislation providing **tax incentives** for gun safes or other storage devices





Out-of-Home Storage

- Normalize voluntary and temporary storage of firearms outside the home - at an FFL, law enforcement department, or a trusted family member
- Create & share gun storage maps

 Colorado, Maryland,
 Mississippi, New Jersey, New
 York, and Washington





Notification Programs

California, New York and **Washington** require K-12 schools to share secure storage information with parents each year; **Utah** requires it when a child exhibits warning signs or suicidal ideation.

Local Ordinances and Secure Storage Resolutions

Local governments can strengthen secure firearm storage laws beyond state law where not preempted.

School Boards across the nation have adopted secure storage resolutions.

Students have often led the way on these advocacy efforts.







Be SMART

Moms Demand Action volunteers across the country advocate for the Be SMART program in their communities.

Be SMART has partnered with national, state, and local educational organizations, medical associations, departments of health, law enforcement agencies, and public safety coalitions.
